Pen Portrait – Committee Member Peter Williams

I was trained as a Primary School Teacher in Wellington from 1950-52 and retired in 1989 after 40 years unbroken service. On completing my BMus degree I became HOD Music at Naenae College in 1963 and HOD Music at Napier Boys' High School from 1966 till 1975 when I became Music Tutor from 1975 till 1989 at the newly established Hawke's Bay Community College - now Eastern Institute of Technology - where I ran music classes and holiday courses both in Napier and throughout Hawke's Bay, while conducting the Napier Civic Choir and the H B Regional Orchestra. I was given a Civic Award from the Napier City Council and a QSM from Queen Elizabeth in 2005.

I wrote Music Reviews for the Napier *Daily Telegraph*, and then *Hawke's Bay Today*, for 54 years and a fortnightly Music Page for 50 years, was Local Representative for Trinity College, London for 28 years, taught the piano privately, was involved in the H B Branch of the Institute of Registered Music Teachers for many years and was National President for a term, and I play the organ every Sunday at the Methodist Church in Napier.

I have four children, lived in Napier before moving to Frimley Village in Hastings in 2017 where I now live, when my late wife, Valerie, was in care in Colwyn House in Hastings.
