This is a new requirement from the restaurant as they will not take individual payments for a set menu. These choices include Hot Grilled Ham, hot ham off the bone served with grilled pineapple rings, fries & salad. Fish of the Day, battered, crumbed or pan-fried served with salad & fries. Chicken Breast, grilled chicken breast, topped with tomato & chilly salsa, grilled with cheese, served with new potatoes & salad. Minute Steak, Tender Ribeye steak grilled, served with salad & fries, mushroom or pepper sauce. Deserts provided will be Christmas pudding, served with custard & cream. The committee will be providing on the table's wines & orange juice, along with a Christmas cake for all attending to enjoy.
